**ORDINANCE 765**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 ARTICLE VIII OF ORDINANCE 708 PERTAINING TO THE OPERATION OF THE MUNICIPAL SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS:

**Section 1. Section 5, Article VIII of Ordinance 708 shall be amended to read as follows:**


Prior to the issuance of any permit for initial service to any structure, the city shall charge any applicant for sewer service a connection fee of \$2,500. This fee is to include the tap and all costs incidental to the connection. Should the applicant's connection require boring into the street applicant shall also pay the actual cost of the boring. Should the applicant's connection require opening a street then applicant is responsible for all costs of street repair by city contractor.

After receipt of actual costs any excess monies up to the \$2,500 will be applied to the customers utility account as a credit.


**Section 2. Effective Date.**

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
