ORDINANCE NO. 740

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6 OF
ORDINANCE NO. 737 PERTAINING TO FACE
COVERINGS AND OTHER COVID-19
RESTRICTIONS.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN,
KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 737 shall be amended as follows:

“Section 6. Bars, night clubs, and other businesses licensed to sell alcohol. All bars, night clubs, and other businesses licensed to sell alcohol for on-premises consumption can stay open until 11:00 P.M; daily. These establishments shall be limited to no more than 100 patrons or 50 percent of the fire code capacity, whichever is less. They may continue carry-out and curbside services past these times. Restaurants may seat parties of no more than six people per table.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
