**ORDINANCE NO. 562**

AN ORDINANCE, REGARDING CONTROL OF ANIMALS IN GENERAL & REGULATING THE USE OF TRAPS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS:

**SECTION 1.** No animal owner shall keep or harbor any animal, which by loud frequent or habitual barking, howling, yelping or other noise or action, unreasonably disturbs any person or neighborhood within the corporate limits of the city of Garden Plain, Kansas. Any person so affected directly may sign a complaint.

**SECITON 2.** It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to use, setout or deploy any animal trap above ground, with the exception of Sedgwick County Animal Control for the purpose of trapping domestic animals within the city limits of Garden Plain, Kansas.

**SECTION 3.** Any person, firm or corporation found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be fined in an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or be imprisoned not to exceed thirty days (30) or be fined and imprisoned.
