THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS

ORDINANCE NO. 618

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN TIMES FOR SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMITS ON SECTION LINE ROAD (ALSO KNOWN AS 295TH WEST) AND ON WEST HARRY (ALSO KNOWN AS OLD HIGHWAY 54) IN THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS:

Section 1. The 20 mile per hour school zone speed limit shall be in effect in the school zone on West Harry (AKA Old Highway 54) in the City of Garden Plain during the following times:

7:45 A.M.. - 8:15 A.M..
3:15 P.M.. - 4:00 P.M..

Said school zone is located at a point starting approximately 30 yards west of Section Line Road (AKA 295th West) and ending at a point approximately 350 yards west of Section Line Road in the City of Garden Plain.

Section 2. The 20 mile per hour school zone speed limit shall be in effect in the school zone on Section Line Road (AKA 295th West) in the City of Garden Plain during the following times:

7:45 A.M.. - 8:15 A.M..
3:15 P.M.. - 4:00 P.M .

Said school zone is located at a point starting approximately 320 yards south of West Harry (AKA Old Highway 54) and ending at a point approximately 485 yards south of West Harry in the City of Garden Plain.

Section 3. This Ordinance repeals City of Garden Plain Ordinance No. 385 and all previous ordinances conflicting herewith.
