ORDINANCE NO. 746

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 737 AND 740 REQUIRING THE WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS AND OTHER COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS, IN THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, securing the health, safety, and economic well-being of residents of the City of Garden Plain, Kansas is a priority of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services declared a public health emergency for COVID-19 beginning January 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, a State of Disaster Emergency was proclaimed for the State of Kansas on March 12, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas declared a State of Local Disaster Emergency within the county on March 16, 2020; and

WHEREAS, for the aforementioned and other reasons, and in recognition and furtherance of our responsibility to provide for the health, safety, security, and welfare of the people of the City of Garden Plain, requiring face coverings be worn in public spaces is necessary to promote and secure the health, safety and protection of the citizens of our community in the most efficient manner.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Garden Plain, Kansas, hereby repeals Ordinance numbers 737 and 740.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
