**ORDINANCE 764**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 722 PERTAINING TO THE OPERATION OF THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS:

**Section 1. Section "1" of Ordinance 722 shall be amended to read as follows:**

CONNECTION FEES. Anyone making application for and desiring to connect with the water system of the city of Garden Plain shall pay the following amounts for a connection fee:

\$2,500 for applicants inside or outside the city limits of Garden Plain


Said payment shall include the cost of a single ¾" meter. The additional cost of any larger meter shall be borne by the consumer, together with all costs incidental to the installation of said meter and bringing water to it. Should the applicant's connection require boring into the street applicant shall also pay the actual cost of the boring. Should the applicant's connection require opening a street then applicant is responsible for all costs of street repair by city contractor. If a consumer is outside the city limits of The City of Garden Plain, lines can only be run within 500 feet of each side of main line, said consumer shall pay the additional expense of installing a water line to the premises.

After receipt of actual costs, any excess monies up to the \$2,500 will be applied to the customers utility account as a credit.

**Section 2. Effective Date.**

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
