

RESOLUTION 255

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PRICING FOR THE MUNICIPAL SEWER SERVICE OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the governing Body of the city of Garden Plain, Kansas has established an ordinance governing the operation of the Municipal Sewer System; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Garden Plain, Kansas seeks to establish uniform rates for consumers of the Municipal Sewer System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS:

1. There is hereby levied on all firms, persons, corporations, organizations, political units and political subdivisions, and all other entities and persons with premises in or outside the corporate limits of city of Garden Plain, Kansas, as presently defined, or hereafter altered or amended, and now or hereafter connected with the sewage system of said city, sewage service charges as herein provided.

2. USER FEES:

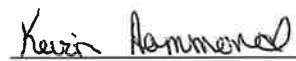
- a. All residences within the city, including mobile homes, shall be assessed and charged \$63.00 per month for sewer service.
- b. Renwick USD 267 will be charged a rate of \$1984.50 per month for all buildings.
- c. All owners of the following establishments will be charged a monthly sewer service charge as indicated. However, should any establishment fall within two or more of the classifications, that classification with the highest monthly rate will prevail.

1. Taverns/Party Rental	\$ 75.60
2. Gas Stations	\$ 73.50
3. Car Washes	\$174.30
4. Garage and Vehicle Repair shops	\$ 75.60
5. Nonresidential (less than 6 employees)	\$ 63.00
6. Nonresidential (6 employees or more)	\$103.95
7. Barber and Beauty Shops	\$ 75.60
8. Food Service Establishments	\$116.55

9. Mortuaries	\$100.80
10. St Anthony Church and Hall	\$100.80
11. Kanza Coop	\$259.35
12. Homecare Facilities	\$105.00

- d. All customers outside the city limits shall be charged on all rates and fees twenty percent (20%) more than the city classification for the establishment.
