ORDINANCE NO 801

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE “UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES, 42nd EDITION” OF 2026, WITH CERTAIN CHANGES AND ADDITIONS; PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 791 AND ALL OTHER CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARDEN PLAIN, KANSAS:

Section 1. Incorporating Uniform Public Offense Code.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate city limits of the City of Garden Plain, Kansas, that certain uniform public offense code know as the “Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities,” 42nd Edition of 2026, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, sections, parts, or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omissions or changes and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge, and all administrative departments of the City charged with enforcement of the Ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Uniform Public Offense Code similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

Section 2. Repeal.

This Ordinance repeals City of Garden Plain Ordinance No. 791 and all other previous ordinances conflicting herewith.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and publication once in the official City paper.
